

Whole School Collective Worship - 'Through the sign of the cross we follow Jesus'

Mrs Winnery led our whole school worship yesterday morning. Mrs Winnery had images of famous celebrities as children and the pupils were asked to guess who they were from a set of clues. The celebrities included David Beckham, Lewis Hamilton and Kate Middleton. Mrs Winnery said that if these celebrities came to our school we would recognise them instantly and know their jobs.

Mrs Winnery then asked the children "If Jesus walked into our school would we recognise him? Who would we say he is?" We then heard the Gospel reading from St Mark from Mass on Sunday.

'Who do people say that I am?"

They said in reply, "John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others one of the prophets." And he asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter said to him in reply, "You are the Christ."

Many of his own people did not recognise who Jesus was and he was rejected by the people who were supposed to know who he was claiming to be-the Messiah. Peter recognised who Jesus was not because he'd been told but because of what he's witnessed Jesus *do.* The children were asked to think about how they could show that they were followers of Jesus in all that they do this week.

Every child and adult in school has created a little person representing themselves with one of their gifts and talents they can share and they are proud of. These will form the display in the hall 'Through the sign of the cross we follow Jesus'
