The Feast of Christ the King

Mr Copley led our whole school worship yesterday. We began by listening to Sunday's Gospel reading, The Feast of Christ the King. The children were asked to imagine their heart was a kingdom and to picture all the people in their lives who were close to them. They were asked who they would like as the ruler of their Kingdom. We had many answers but the first one was 'Jesus'.

The Feast of Christ the King is a relatively new feast that was introduced by the Pope at the end of World War 1. He felt all nations needed to be reminded that God is King not power... and everything comes from God.

We have a monarchy who are very special and are very much involved but nothing in comparison to our God who is King of all our hearts.

Mr Copley took a pack of cards and showed children the Kings. He then showed the children a story which helped them understand that Christ is the King of our hearts.

Pope Francis has described the heart as the place where we are truly ourselves and that this is where God meets us, if we let Him.

When we allow Christ into our lives – when we allow Him to become the King of our hearts – we experience the joy, peace, mercy



and love that He brings. Our mission was to show other people that Christ is in our hearts.
