

Dear Parents, Carers and Parishioners

On the 29th June the Church celebrates the Feast day of two great Saints - St Peter and St Paul. Without St Peter and St Paul it is hard to imagine what the global church would be like or whether it would even exist. Mrs Winnery began worship by asking the children what these two Saints were best remembered for. The children knew that these Saints had helped to spread the good news all around the world and helped people to know about Jesus and become Christians.

Mrs Winnery showed the children a map of the world and asked if they knew someone in another country. The children were keen to name family and friends in Poland, America and the Philippines. Mrs Winnery told the children that thanks to St Peter and St Paul we all have family who live in other countries- our Church family and that today's worship would help us think about how we can be close to them and love them in our prayers.

Mrs Winnery next showed the children a World Mission Rosary which was brightly coloured and explained that each decade of the rosary was a different colour to represent five different continents of the world. The children then enjoyed learning about which colour represented which continent and how children in that continent were being helped in practical ways through our prayers and by a charity called 'Mission Together'. This is the Pope's official children's charity. Mrs Winnery asked the



children to choose a continent they wanted to pray for and led the children in saying one decade of the rosary together. The Worship concluded with the children being encouraged to continue to say the Mission Rosary at home and at school.

Year 5 held a beautiful worship for parents and school to remind us all of the need to be welcoming and inclusive to all who seek sanctuary and refuge. It was very moving and thoughtful. Well done.

Refugee Week

We received a lovely email regarding the launch of Refugee Week by our Year 3 children at Margaret McMillan Tower last week.

Yesterday afternoon I attended the launch of Refugee Week in Bradford at the Margaret McMillan Tower. A representative from your school was presented with the School of Sanctuary award, which was very good to see. Even more impressive was the singing by a group of a dozen children, who sang two songs and used sign language at the same time. The joy on their faces was really quite moving, and they received by far the biggest round of applause for any of the groups performing.
