

## Through the sign of the cross we follow Jesus

#### **Dear Parents, Carers and Parishioners**

Next Sunday 10th July is known as **Sea Sunday**. This is an important day for the Church worldwide when we focus on seafarers and pray for them, their families and those who support them.



In this week's Worship Mrs Winnery helped the children to understand why Sea Sunday is an important event in the Church calendar. Mrs Winnery began with the question, "Where is God's Kingdom?" Instead of taking answers Mrs Winnery whispered the answer to Hanah and John and sent then off to tell as many people in the hall as possible. Soon everyone knew the answer "God's Kingdom is very near to us."

Mrs Winnery then read this week's gospel where Jesus sends out seventy-two disciples in pairs to share the news that "**God's Kingdom is near.**" She said that Jesus sent his disciples out on an adventure in pairs, just like Hanah and John. God's Kingdom was not on a map and did not have a fancy palace, it was wherever God lives and he lives in each of us!

Mrs Winnery went on to explain about **Sea Sunday** and how port chaplains are just like those disciples who go out and spread news of God's love and friendship. We all watched a video of Wojciech, a port chaplain, and learnt how he helped seafarers who came to Britain to know God's love and friendship. He would visit them in hospital, give them warm woolly hats and pray with them. We heard how they were thousands of miles away from their families and were lonely or sad.

In our final prayer we asked God to help us to be more like the disciples and Wojciech by going out and sharing our love and friendship with others.

#### One God, One World Liturgy

On Monday Miss McAlpine took six Mini Vinnies to St William's Church for a liturgy with the Catholic Schools Partnership.

The Journey of our One God, One World project began with a simple aim: to unite the Catholic schools and parishes of Bradford and Keighley together. As a partnership we took inspiration from Pope Francis' encyclical Laudato Si' which talked about the importance of caring for our common home and protecting the world for future generations. Since the start of Lent art work from each school has been travelling around the parishes for everyone to see our creative responses and understand the Pope's message. The children all gathered together as representatives from their school community as the art exhibition reached its final parish - St William's. We celebrated the success of the project and remembered our mission to be good stewards of God's creation.
