Dear Parents, Carers and Parishioners

In Monday's Worship, we present a contemporary retelling of the story of the Good Samaritan using a simple narrated drama. The purpose of this was to offer pupils the chance to think about who their neighbour really is and what it means to be a good one. Niamh, Ida, Malaika and Adrian helped Mrs Winnery act out a story about a young girl who was lost and frightened in a big city but people had just walked away. In thinking about how they might have reacted, pupils begin to think about how their actions affect others. The story asked some challenging questions for the children: Are we sometimes too busy to stop and help someone? Too embarrassed? Worried about how others might view us? Is it sometimes easier to walk away and do nothing?

At the end of the Worship the children were encouraged to reach out to others in need.

This will be an excellent opportunity for the children to think about their time at St Cuthbert's and their future at their new schools as well as later in life.
