

Dear Parents, Carers and Parishioners

In this week's Gospel reading, Jesus warned His disciples about difficult times ahead. He spoke of wars, earthquakes, famine and plague that would challenge the disciples' faith. Yet he also reassured them that He would always be with them and that they only had to put their trust in Him and they would be safe from harm.



In Worship on Monday we explored the work of CAFOD and their response to natural disasters, such as the recent earthquake in Haiti and floods in Pakistan. How Jesus shows He is with us is often through the actions of others and by supporting the work of charities such as CAFOD, we can help bring Jesus' love to parts of the world that need it most.
