

Dear Parents, Carers and Parishioners



This weekend was the feast of Christ the King, which marks the end of the liturgical year. In worship yesterday, the children were asked to suggest what made a good king. The responses ranged from 'getting' your servants to make things for you' to 'giving money to the poor'. We listened to a story about a village that experienced four different kings:

- ▼ The King of Hearts loved his people, but was banished because the villagers thought that a better king would come along.
- * The King of Clubs let his subjects party every day but his rule ended in greed and laziness.
- The King of Diamonds was wealthy and gave money to everybody, but their greed and jealousy forced him to flee and led to unhappiness.
- ▲ The King of Spades ruled by fear and encouraged the villagers to trust no-one, but they became lonely and frightened.

Eventually, the villagers begged the King of Hearts for forgiveness and re-established him as King. Mrs Walsh talked about Christ as the King of our Hearts and that leading by love was the example we should all follow.
