

SCHOOL MILK

Changes to School Milk Provision – Advance Notice

This is the last time you will be able to order milk through school. From the beginning of April 2017 (Summer Term) school milk provision will be changing and parents will have to register with the school milk website to order, and pay, for milk. More information about the new system will be coming home during next term. **When a child reaches their 5th birthday they now have to pay for milk**, but as a school, we will not introduce this until the term after the child has reached their 5th birthday.

If your child would like to have milk when we come back to school in January please fill in the slip below and return to school by **Friday 16th December 2016**.



Children who are in receipt of **free school meals** (**not universal infant free school meals**) are entitled to **free school milk**. Children in Nursery and Reception children under the age of 5 receive free school milk.
