

#### **Top Table and Healthy Eating!**



A few weeks ago, the School Council decided to start a healthy eating programme to try and turn our school lunch hall into a happy and healthy community. Every lunch time, a few members of the School Council have become the 'Healthy Food Police' and have been monitoring children's lunch choices to ensure they are including fruit and vegetables into their meal (and eating them!)

We have been keeping a tally of the number of 'Healthy Choice' stickers given out to each class to see

who is going to be named the healthiest! Can anyone catch Year 6 who are the front-runners at the moment?

#### We now need your help!

If your child brings a packed lunch to school, please help them to make healthy choices of what to bring in their lunch box. You could try to reduce the number of sugary items, such as chocolate bars, brioche, jam and biscuits, and add an extra item of fruit to help them collect their 'Healthy Choice' stickers. Change4Life leaflets about healthy eating were handed out last week and there are posters around school, made by the school council, that show the components of a healthy plate.



It is very important that all children eat fruit and vegetables, along with other food groups every day, in order to improve their energy levels, brain functioning and even their mood.

We have also been thinking about our behaviour in the dining room. Our Year 5 monitors have been looking out for children who are showing excellent table manners; such as eating with a knife and fork, trying new foods, clearing their plate and sitting sensibly while eating.
