Safer Internet Day and Online Safety Warning

Next **Tuesday 7th February** is Safer Internet Day. The theme for this year is 'Be the change: Unite for a better Internet' and throughout the school day there will be a range of activities for children inviting them to think about their online behaviour and safety. This is particularly relevant, as only last week a Bradford primary school released shocking information about an incident involving some of their Year 6 pupils and an app called **live.ly**, which is connected to **music.ly**. A man, unknown to the pupils involved, intruded on a group chat on the app and exposed himself. The app is considered unsafe to use by children because of the ease at which people can join the group chats and the risk this presents in relation to grooming and sexual exploitation. We advise all our parents to be aware of these dangers.



As part of our commitment to ensuring the online safety of our pupils, we have booked a talk for parents and carers from PCSO Luke Carson of the Police's Cyber Crime Team. This will be held from **6-8pm** on **Thursday 9th February** and we invite all parents to attend
