#### **Dear Parents, Guardians and Parishioners**



#### **Enterprise Day**

We started this week with a Mission from the Enabling Enterprise Team named Operation Moonbase. Across the school, from Nursery to Year 6, children were set the task of creating a new society on Utopia through a series of challenges. Throughout the day, they were being judged and supported in developing 8 key skills: Aiming high, working as a team, sharing ideas, using imagination,



leading, problem solving, listening carefully and staying positive.



To create their society on Utopia they had to select a crew, design the perfect animal, choose and design buildings and then pitch their designs. Each class selected a winning team based not solely on their design but through

#### Year 6 visit to Brewin Dolphin

It was clear how much the children enjoyed the day and really flourished with some fantastic feedback from the company of how polite and hardworking the class are.
