**Through the sign of the cross we follow Jesus**

### Dear Parents, Guardians and Parishioners

For our first Worship of the new term and our first gathering together as a school community after Easter, we began with a joyful exclamation! Mrs Winnery called out "Jesus is Risen!" three times, and the children respond with the word, "Alleluia" which Mrs Winnery explained means "Praise God".



At Easter we celebrated Jesus rising from the dead and Mrs Winnery asked the children to imagine how they would have felt if they had met Jesus in the garden. To help them do this Nella, in Year 4, read the Gospel story of when Mary Magdala went to the tomb where Jesus had been buried to see His body. There, Mary saw an angel who told her He had risen from the dead. When Mary ran off to tell the others she came face to face with Jesus who told her not to be afraid. The children considered how they would have felt and how Mary must have experienced a lot of emotions when she met the risen Jesus, such as happiness, excitement and fear. Mrs Winnery told the children that Mary was also **thankful** because Jesus was giving new life to everyone.

As the children were invited to think about how we can also be thankful to Jesus, because we too receive new life from him, they listened to the gentle worship song 'All I Have to Say' and looked at images of new life. Worship finished with a final prayer of praise.

## School Milk – IMPORTANT INFORMATION

**This is the only way to order milk for your child.**  
**Payment and orders CANNOT be made to the school office.**



It is not too late to order milk for your child but you will need to order and pay for milk online through **FP School Milk UK Ltd** for children aged 5 and above. The process of ordering and paying for your child's milk is quick and easy. Milk for the under-fives is free until the beginning of the term in which the child turns five. You do not need to order milk for under 5's. Milk is free for children who are entitled to Free School Meals (where you have had to apply to the Benefit Service through Bradford Council Benefit Office). Milk is **NOT free** for children who are entitled to **Universal Free School Meals**. This scheme entitles children from Reception, Year 1 and 2 to free meals but not free milk.

Leaflets with full details have already been sent out to every child.
